Type I/II/IV Parking Permit

This is to advise that the current Parking Permits issued in 2024-25 are due for renewal before 1 September 2025.

Renewal

Type I/II/IV Permit

Replacement of Type I/II/IV Parking Permit and/or RFID tag is NOT required unless there is a change in the vehicle registration particulars. The Estates Office (EO) will extend the validity of the parking right for one year (from September 2025 to August 2026) upon receipt of a record of payment of the annual fee from a Type I/II/IV Parking Permit holder.

Payment of Annual Fee (\$1,320 for Type I Permit; \$660 for Type II/IV Permit)
