

Hong Kong Baptist University Electric Vehicle Charging Service Terms and Conditions

By using the Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Service provided by Hong Kong Baptist University (HKBU), users are deemed to have read, understood, and agreed to comply with the following Terms and Conditions.

Eligibility and Access

1. The EV Charging Service is provided by HKBU for licensed electric vehicles certified by the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.
2. Users must hold a valid HKBU parking permit or be an invited guest and must comply with the *HKBU Campus Traffic and Parking Regulations* at all times.
3. The EV Charging Service is available only at designated EV charging spaces. Use of EV charging spaces must be accessed through the “Smart EV Charging” feature in the HKBU Mobile app. HKBU does not provide advance reservation or queuing arrangements.
4. Limited EV charging spaces are equipped with Octopus payment station for charging by invited guests.

Charging Service and Fees

5. The charging service fee schedule is as follows:

<i>Charging Service Fee:</i>	<i>\$2.5 per kWh</i>
<i>Minimum Charge for Each Session:</i>	<i>\$20</i>

6. The service fees shall be settled upon completion of each charging session. HKBU reserves the right to review the fee schedule from time to time, as deemed necessary.
7. The charging speed is generally up to 7 kW per hour. However, if multiple users are charging at the same time, the charging speed may be reduced due to load sharing among the charging stations.
8. HKBU does not guarantee that the EV Charging Service will be continuously available or compatible with all EV models.

User Responsibilities

9. Users shall comply with the EV Charging Service User Guide and ensure that the charging operation is carried out safely.

10. Users shall bring their own charging cable that meets the following specifications:

Connector:	<i>IEC Type 2 AC Connector</i>
Universal Compatibility:	<i>Fully compliant with IEC 62196 standard</i>
Maximum Power:	<i>3-phase/1-phase 32A</i>

11. Users are responsible for ensuring that their EV, charging cable and connectors are in good condition, compatible with the charging equipment, and connected safely without causing obstruction or hazards.

12. Upon completion of charging, users must disconnect and properly store their charging cable before leaving the charging bay.

Liability

13. Users are responsible for any loss, injury or damage arising from their improper, negligent or unreasonable use of the EV Charging Service and shall indemnify HKBU against any resulting claims or liabilities.

14. To the fullest extent permitted by law, HKBU shall not be liable for any direct or indirect loss, injury, death or property damage arising from the use of, or inability to use, the EV Charging Service.

General Provisions

15. All parking spaces, with or without EV charging facilities, are provided on a first-come, first-served basis for holders of a valid University parking permit.

16. HKBU reserves the right to restrict, suspend or terminate the EV Charging Service, or a user's access to the service, at any time for operational, maintenance, safety or security reasons, or in the event of a breach of these Terms and Conditions.

17. HKBU reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions without prior notice.
